



Propel is a one-year residential mission program based at our centrally located Booth College Bexley North campus in Sydney. It is designed to equip you for life, mission and ministry.

Propel integrates formal learning and real world experience through placements that will have a strong mission and justice focus.

Students will live in the student hostels on campus and be part of a campus community. You will complete a Diploma in Christian Studies and gain practical hands-on experience working alongside people in frontline ministry. You will be shaped as you experience church planting, evangelism and cross cultural ministry, all with a strong emphasis on your personal spiritual formation.

Propel has two key elements – theory and practical. You will attend classes on campus as you study towards graduating with a Diploma of Christian Studies. For the practical element, you will travel around Sydney and possibly Australia depending on where your ministry placement is.

DIPLOMA OF CHRISTIAN STUDIES

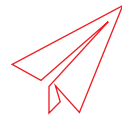
You will be stimulated, challenged and stretched as you study the Diploma of Christian Studies along with your fellow learners and our experienced faculty.
